Panel Application Criteria & Form

Panel Criteria and Selection Procedure

Persons wishing to apply to the AMCC domestic and international arbitrator and/or mediator panels must demonstrate an appropriate level of expertise and experience in arbitration and/or mediation and be of good standing and character.

For the AMCC International Arbitrator and/or Mediator Panel, applicants will be required to meet the preferred standards set out below:

- at least 10 years post qualification experience;
- For arbitration:
 - a fellowship from the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, or any comparable professional arbitration institution;
 - experience as an arbitrator in five or more international cases;
 - completion of at least two arbitration awards.
- For mediation:
 - accreditation by an internationally recognised professional mediation provider, such as the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution;
 - experience as a mediator in five or more commercial mediation cases with international parties.

For the Domestic Arbitrator and/or Mediator Panel, in general, applicants will be required to meet the preferred standards set out below:

- at least 8 years post qualification experience;
- For arbitration:
 - a fellowship from the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, or any comparable professional arbitration institution;
 - experience as an arbitrator in two or more cases; and
 - completion of at least one arbitration award.
- For mediation:
 - accreditation by an internationally recognised professional mediation provider, such as the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution;
 - experience as a mediator in two or more commercial mediation cases.

The AMCC reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to admit or to refuse the admission of any person to the panels. In exercising this discretion, the AMCC will have regard to, inter alia, the qualifications, experience and standing of an applicant as well as to the number of arbitrators and mediators currently on the panel overall, and from the country in which the applicant is resident.

Access to the information provided by applicants will be restricted to a limited number of authorised AMCC staff and the ADR Court for the purpose of assessment for panel listing. The data may also be used for equal opportunities monitoring. Information marked with a

[*] shall be publicly available on the AMCC website.

Following the application and selection procedure, the application form shall be retained in a file established by the AMCC for each applicant together with other submitted information and data, for as long as it deems necessary or useful. Applicants have the right to request access to, and the correction of, their personal data and may do so by submitting written requests to the Director General of the AMCC.

If you wish to make an application, please submit the following:

- a completed application form (below);
- a recent high-resolution photograph;
- an up-to-date professional CV
- copies of sanitised arbitral awards - one (domestic arbitration) or two (international arbitration), as appropriate; and
- two written references.
